And while there have been many demonstrations of autonomous vehicle technologies that could potentially replace some driver duties in the future, it is important to keep in mind that demonstration is not commercialization, and these technologies have yet to prove themselves in real-world applications on a repeatable basis."

Support beyond Technology

Bendix's support of drivers also extends beyond the equipment it provides, through the company's training and education programs, as well as industry outreach participation and sponsorships.

To celebrate drivers' skills and commitment, Bendix has served as the sole sponsor of the annual ATA National Truck Driving Championships (NTDC) Grand Champion Award for the past seven years. This year's NTDC champion was Roland Bolduc, an East Longmeadow, Massachusetts-based professional driver for FedEx Express.
