The NTDC features the winners from 50 state trucking associations' truck driving championships. All competitors must drive accident-free for at least one year before qualifying for the competition. In Pittsburgh, more than 420 of these top-notch drivers are expected to compete in the championship event, testing their expertise through a written exam, personal interview, pre-trip inspection test, and skills-based competition course.

Inside the David L. Lawrence Convention Center, drivers must demonstrate extensive knowledge of safety, equipment, and the industry, as well as put their driving abilities to the test. The driving course challenges drivers to maneuver, reverse, park, and position their vehicles with precision over scales, before barriers, and around curves. In the behind-the-wheel skills course, drivers are tested on their ability to handle their trucks, judge distances, and maneuver through tight spots.

Scott Woodrome, a FedEx Freight driver based in Middletown, Ohio, was last year's Grand Champion award winner.
